

***What is dual membership?***

A dual member is a Kappa who belongs to more than one alumnae association.

***Who can be a dual member?***

Any Kappa can be a dual member of more than one association.

***How is dual membership different from regular membership?***

The Kappa pays her Fraternity per capita fee to one association with that association's local dues. She pays only the local dues to the other association(s), as her Fraternity fees are paid only **once** during the fiscal year by only **one** association.

***How is it determined where the member will pay her Fraternity per capita fees?***

The Kappa herself determines to which alumnae association she pays her Fraternity fees. The Fraternity fees are the same for every Kappa no matter to which association she pays them. Alumnae association dues may vary from one association to another as the association's budget determines the local dues. Therefore, a dual member pays her Fraternity fees and the association's dues to one association, but to another association she pays only that association's dues and no Fraternity fees.

***Do both associations list the Kappa on their membership roster when submitting per capita fees to Fraternity Headquarters?***

You may list the dual dues-paying member on your membership roster if you would like her name and contact information included on your galleys. Please indicate with **DUAL** next to her name.
